Registration Now Open for Birchway Niagara's Annual Brunch, Bid & Bowl Event

NIAGARA FALLS, ONTARIO, January 19, 2024 – Birchway Niagara (formerly Women's Place), invites members of our community to support survivors of domestic violence by registering for this year's Brunch, Bid & Bowl event at brunchbidandbowl.org. Participants will be fundraising to empower women and children in our community to build a safer future while coming together to celebrate International Women's Day.

The March 9th event, which is presented by Niagara Casinos, will include a morning of brunch, fun and fundraising at Club Italia before participants head to Cataract Bowl to celebrate their fundraising success.

<u>Layne, The Auctionista</u>, will be returning to emcee this year's event. With their magnetic stage presence and ability to connect participants to the cause, The Auctionista will ensure that participants have a great experience creating a community of support for the hundreds of women and children who use Birchway Niagara services each year.

"When the Niagara Region declared intimate partner violence an epidemic late last year, it reflected the struggle that shelters like ours face to keep up with the need for domestic violence services," explains Birchway Niagara's executive director, Jennifer Gauthier. "Community support for Birchway Niagara's fundraising events like Brunch, Bid & Bowl has never been more critical, and I would encourage everyone to consider participating on March 9th or donating to one of the teams taking part."

WHAT:

A one-day event in which participants will enjoy a buffet-style brunch, live & silent auctions, a "heads and tails activity" (for a chance to win a \$750 Outlet Collection gift card), and 1.5 hours of bowling at Cataract Bowl. Teams will raise funds online in the weeks and months leading up to March 9.

9:30 a.m. – Doors open at Club Italia (2525 Montrose Rd, Niagara Falls) approx. 2:30 p.m. – Bowling starts at Cataract Bowl (7906 Lundy's

Lane, Niagara Falls)

opportunity for friends, family members and colleagues to come

together for a wonderful cause and a great time!

COST: There is no registration fee for teams of 6-8 players who reach the

minimum fundraising goal of \$800. Bowlers may also register individually if they would like Birchway Niagara to find them some teammates by joining one of our "Bowling Buddies" teams. Guests who do not wish to join a bowling team can also purchase tickets to take part in the brunch, auctions and "heads and tails" portions of the

event.
